2025

PCA is formed in Edmonton on September 16 with 6 members

Saskatchewan embraces fair and open tendering (**Bill 80**), allowing PCA members to work with all-employee bargaining units due to PCA advocacy

2012

New suite of advisory services developed and introduced for PCA contractor members

PCA becomes founding & Board member of BuildForce Canada



2015

PCA holds first Government Engagement Day, supported by CLAC

Membership reaches 100 contractor organizations

2018



Fair and open tendering is achieved in Ontario for major infrastructure projects in the province due to PCA's advocacy efforts

PCA accomplishes its primary advocacy goal in Ontario through the passage of **Bill 66** which allows the majority of municipalities to tender their construction work to ALL contractors, regardless of union affiliation

3 Year Open Periods in BC Open periods move from yearly to every 3 years because of PCA advocacy *The BC NDP government reverted back to annual open periods in 2020

2020

Skilled Trades Ontario replaces Ontario College of Trades with substantial input from PCA

Introduction of all-employee bargaining units in Alberta

2022

PCA leads industry in opposition to the federal government's restrictive and costly Investment Tax credit (ITC)

Appointed to the *Alberta Board of Skilled Trades*
